Consequently, the image of the individual volunteer (without linking this image to the relevant personal data) may also be recorded and made public in such a context.

Basic information on volunteering:

- detailed volunteer regulations: <https://kwitnacy-dom.pl/regulamin-wolontariatu/> ;
- a volunteer can be: a person of full age, a person over 13 with parental consent and any younger person under the care of a parent or designated guardian,
- the volunteer services take place at the location given above - it is up to the volunteer and his/her guardian, if any, to get home safely,
- minors with contact allergies may only perform volunteer services in the presence of a guardian,
- minors may only carry out light work during volunteering, not involving carrying loads,
- the duration of the voluntary service of a minor during 1 day may not exceed 6 hours,
- in the case of minors, the guardians of the volunteer are responsible for ensuring that the volunteer activities do not interfere with the volunteer's school duties,
- the volunteer coordinator is responsible for providing personal protective equipment and health and safety instructions and the volunteer is strictly obliged to follow these guidelines.
